



LARGE WHITE BREED

"ALL SHOWS" TROPHY

RULES

(Including amendment October 1985)



Any breeders wishing to compete for this trophy in 2010 must register with the Show Committee Deputy Chairman – Nick Kiddy

1. Shows earning qualifying points are confined to Great Britain (The Pack-Beresford Trophy applies in Northern Ireland)
2. Royal Smithfield Show OPENS the year, for which awards are considered, i.e. the result for 1985 includes 1984 Smithfield; the 1986 result will include Smithfield 1985.
3. Only Shows having a separate section (classes) for Large White's are to be considered.
4. A minimum of three exhibitors is necessary if awards are to be credited.
5. Points are awarded on the following bases:

1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th
6	5	4	3	2	1

If the pig becomes Male/Female Champion – increase points to 8

If the pig becomes Reserve Male/Female Champion – increase points to 7

If the pig becomes Breed Champion – increase points to 10

If the pig becomes Reserve Breed Champion – increase points to 9

(In practice this means for example the a 2nd prize pig (boar) that is later made Reserve Male, then goes on to be Reserve Breed, scores 5+2+2=9. The same method applies to others.

6. **ROYAL SHOW** awards score **DOUBLE POINTS**
7. **Royal Smithfield Show.** Only the awards for pairs score, plus the Champion Pairs in each weight category and the Supreme/ Reserve Supreme in Show if these are pedigree Large White. A 1st prize pair of Large White cutters later becoming Champion cutter pigs, the Reserve Supreme Pair of pigs in Show would score 6+2+1=9.
8. Events to be considered are:

 - Lincolnshire
 - Newark & Notts
 - North Wales
 - RASE
 - Royal Bath & West
 - X Royal Highland
 - X Royal Smithfield
 - X Royal Welsh
 - Staffordshire
 - Three Counties
 - Gt. Yorkshire
