The latest survey, completed in the early months of 2009, shows a sizeable reduction the number of registered sows, down from 656 to 567. A matter for further concern is that nearly 40% of these sows had not in the past year produced any pedigree or eligible offspring. They had either been used for crossbreeding, or produced litters from Berkshire boars that were then not birth notified, and any progeny was lost to the breed. In terms of individual bloodlines the lowest number is in the *Mermaid* line, one of the oldest female lines in the Berkshire breed.

Boar numbers, on the other hand, have held up well and are, at 155, just one up on the previous year. The biggest decline in any boar line is in the newest Berkshire line, *Lassetter* which has only 8 registered boars. However with the current financial climate and in light of problems faced by breeders generally, it is encouraging to see only a very small decline on the previous year in the number of pedigree breeders keeping Berkshires. Their help over completing this survey is very much appreciated.

BPA BRITISH SADDLEBACK BLOODLINE SURVEY

Numbers of both breeders, and British Saddleback pigs, are down in the latest survey, with a drop of 132 sows. It is however encouraging to see that the proportion of these that have produced birth notified litters has not dropped. Boar numbers show a much smaller decline with only 13 less than the last survey.

In the female lines **Mary, Lucy & Duchess** have only 2 sows. **Bountiful & Colleen** with 4 and **Bell & Molly** (5) & **Gamma** (down to 6 from 11) also give rise for concern. The **Choice** line, with only 2 last year, now appears to have been lost.

In the boars the **Generals** are down to 2 boars and **Walter** and **Simon** only have 3 each. Semen for the RBST semen bank is yet to be collected from any of these. However I am pleased to report that the **Dominator** numbers have improved from 2 last year to 5. Lets hope that any further decline in numbers of all the above can be halted and that next year's survey will show the breed on the up again.

Thanks to all those who completed their survey forms. The survey is an essential part of maintaining the herdbook and monitoring the status of our breed and we need all Saddleback breeders to take part in this important conservation exercise.

As usual Countess, Primrose, Dahlia and Princess Freda are the lowest in numbers and they will need to be closely monitored also Bluebell and Princess Joan whose numbers fell by just under 40% and 50% respectively in the last year. All this emphasizes the importance of a Survey, so we can make sure we do not lose any of the family lines in our breed.

I have conducted the Landrace survey now for the past 5 years.

Every year, I report to you that there is a considerable decline in numbers, and yet breeders still persist in not returning surveys. Why is this? Am I doing something wrong? Or are you just not interested? I would really value your thoughts.

The figures published with this summary speak for themselves. A decline in sow numbers by 110 and boars are down by 27.

Although there is a considerable spread of female lines left, the majority appear to be critical in terms of numbers. Crystal, Cynthia, Dina, Kvam and Sally all appear to have been lost. There may be young females about, but without breeders telling me I can only assume that they are dead.

In the boar lines its even worse, with the old established Calesh family (originating at Costock and then to Pingle Eros) now also gone. Bishop, Candidus, Elias, Hawk, Kill, Limbus, Nero, Pasta, Patukka, and Rally only have 1 boar apiece.

They only good news to report is that Robin and Agnes Todd are back in business with there Cappagh herd and have purchased a number of pigs from the now dispersed Millrace herd, saving several lines in particular the Skyliner family. We wish them every success.

I will leave you with this one final thoughtThere are now as many registered Mangalitzta herds as there are Landrace.

Where have all the Large White's gone! Females down 304 and boars showing a massive drop from 234 in 2007 to 114 in this last survey year.

The response to the 2008 survey has again been very mixed, both in terms of response and findings. It would appear that a number of herds have gone out of business or have reduced herd numbers considerably. One of the breeders to cease production is Austin Glasgow at Killycurragh, Along with a number of other leading breeders in Northern Ireland, his contribution to the Large White breed was very considerable.

Once more, the vast majority of pigs remain in three herds. Namely Bellaghy, Seaborough and Tates.

Boar lines show the biggest drop, with a reduction of 120 on the year. The older families continue to support the male section, with Field Marshall, King David and Champion Boy still fairly strong. Field Marshall originating several decades ago at the famous 'Wall' herd of the late W. John Ryman (a past president of the NPBA) and tracing back to the noted 'Lion' family. Snobb boars have shown a huge reduction from 17 in 2007 to just 2 in 2008.

On the female front, it is not much better. Champion Queen no longer exists and it should be noted that there were 71 in the last survey, adding concern as to just how vulnerable these bloodlines are. Belle, Lily, Myosotis and Miss also appear to have disappeared.

When you consider that the Large White pig was one of the three foundation breeds of the NPBA and the incredible contribution that it has made to the pig industry worldwide, it is disheartening to see such a significant drop in numbers. It puts the vulnerability of the breed into perspective when you consider that some traditional breeds numerically, now overshadow this famous animal.

Serious breeders should therefore think hard before they cull sows and boars and make sure that they have sons and daughters available as replacements.

Causes for special concern are the Dorothy, Gold Vase, Jula and Flame lines, which have very low numbers and even lower sows with progeny birth notified.

Steps have been taken to make next years survey easier to complete and at a better time of year. A very big thank you to all those who completed their survey without prompting, and we would all be most grateful if you would take the time to complete next years when it arrives, which will save the surveyors a lot of their valuable time – and money – in chasing those who don't.

The 2009 survey has now been completed and has revealed some worrying trends. Sadly last year's increase in numbers was not sustained and the sow numbers have slipped by 63, though this may in part be due to more accurate recording by some breeders. As with last year there is the same number of registered sows with no birth notifications. The number of Woodlands Ladys has fallen the most, a drop of 25 to 43. Of the others Lady's Maid, Modiste and Purity are very vulnerable.

In the boar lines the Captain and Sovereign have lost ground, the other three lines being fairly stable, a drop of 12 overall.

The number of breeders has also fallen by eighteen and I am aware that two or three more are having to give up. Also between a third and half of all registered Middle Whites are in one herd which makes them even more vulnerable.

Finally I would like to thank everyone for either completing their survey or co-operating on the phone with me.

The latest Tamworth survey is showing 49 sows less than the previous year, with a sharp decline in the *Maple* line which has halved in number. The *Princess's* line, while hardly altering in number, remains the female line with the fewest sows. Of the total of 413 females across all lines only 244 of these have produced birth notified litters. It would therefore be a great bonus for the Tamworth breed if more of the remaining pedigree sows (including both the *Princess & Maple* bloodlines) could be bred to produce pedigree birth notifiable litters in this coming year.

Despite a drop in the number of people keeping registered Tamworths, the Boar figures are holding up pretty well with only 9 less than before. However there has been a further reduction in the *Dream Boy* line with only 4 now remaining. This is

one of the lines that is not yet in the RBST Semen programme and a suitable boar for future AI collection is urgently being sought. I would ask any breeders who have, or are expecting litters from the *Dream Boy* line, to contact me.

This year's **Oxford Sandy & Black** survey was made easier due to the lessons that were learnt after last year's survey. Thank you to all of you who made the effort to complete your own surveys either on line or on paper – This freed up my time to chase the laggards!

One frustration that I experienced this year was difficulty contacting breeders whose information held by the BPA was out of date. – Regrettably there were some who despite my best efforts I didn't manage to contact.

The recent expansion of the herd seems to have slowed somewhat – perhaps that was to be expected given the current commercial climate that we are all operating in. One other frustration is those pigs which are sold to "new" breeders who do not then join the BPA. This has the same effect as killing the pigs off as without the registration of pedigree breeding activity they are of no value in preserving the breed. Please could you all do your utmost to persuade, cajole, & blackmail your pig customers to join the BPA - even going so far as to make it a condition of sale?

The survey process allow the herd book to be as accurate as possible which assists in the close tracking and monitoring of those bloodlines which are getting few in number and hopefully will allow intervention action to be taken early enough so that we don't lose anymore bloodlines.

Thank you to all the Welsh breeders who completed this years survey. This information is crucial in identifying the current status of the Welsh pig in comparison to previous years, highlighting any sow and boar lines in decline and the relevant work which is required to ensure lines are not lost for good.

The results of the survey show a slight increase in sow numbers in 2008 compared to 2007, with the Aconite, Empress, Lioness and Model lines thriving.

Unfortunately it appears that the Goldilocks and Impish lines have been lost as no members have registered sows from these lines. The Luck Girl line has suffered a serious decline, although it remains the most popular of all the sow lines. The Cornflower and Dainty Girl lines seem to have made a revival (identified as being lost in 2007), which highlights the importance of completing the survey to obtain accurate results of sows in production. Lines currently at risk are Cornflower, Dainty Girl, Jean, Marigold, Wakeful and Winchat.

Boar numbers have declined compared to the 2007 results, although no lines have been lost. James and Victor remain the most popular lines. Boar lines currently at risk are Arthur, Earl, Imperial and Ted. The Ted line is at severe risk, with only 1 Ted boar currently registered.

Once again many thanks to all breeders who completed the survey. If you own one of the lines currently at risk, I would urge
