Breeding Pig Section entry fees.

A fee of £15.00 per head is payable at time of entry which comprises an entry fee and transfer fee to the new owner. Entries withdrawn prior to the closing date will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn after this date will not receive a refund.

Birth Notified Fattening Pig Section entry fees

A fee of £10.00 per pen of 2-4 pigs is payable at time of entry. Entries withdrawn prior to the closing date will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn after this date will not receive a refund

Pigs may arrive at the market on the afternoon of Friday 29 April 2011 up to 7 pm or prior to 8 am on Saturday 30 April.2011The market will provide minimum bedding only. Wash out facilities are available on site

Show judging will take place from 8.30 am on Saturday morning

BRITISH PIG ASSOCIATION SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR PIG VENDORS

Every breeding section pig must be entered in the appropriate British Pig Association Herd book BEFORE ENTRY. All entry Forms must be accompanied by a Herd Book certificate.

- 2) Any pig which does not correspond with the catalogue entry or whose earmark is not clear and correct will be rejected. Vendors are reminded that pigs must be identified within 8 weeks of birth or prior to mixing with other pigs which ever happens first, in order to comply with BPA Regulations.
- 3) All animals must have the minimum number of teats as defined by their individual breed standard.
- 4) All pigs are entered for this event under BPA Rules and Regulations.
- 5) All pigs are entered for sale subject to the National Pig Auction Rules.
- 6) A vendor may substitute a breeding pig that is entered in the catalogue, provided that
 - i) It is from the same litter and of the same sex as the entry it replaces
 - ii) It arrives by 7 pm on Friday 29th April 2011
 - iii) It is accompanied by its pedigree certificate and other statutory documents
- 7) A vendor failing to bring forward either an animal entered in the catalogue, or a substitute entry will render the vendor liable loss of entry fee in respect of each animal not presented.
- 8) All pigs will be judged a panel of 3 Judges appointed by the British Pig Association. It is recommended that the vendor should be present when judging is carried out. The panel will be looking for commercially sound breeding animals. Therefore, all pigs will be expected to conform to the Standards of Excellence (copies of which are available from the BPA) for their breed and particular attention will be paid to
 - i) The soundness and number of teats
 - ii) The soundness of legs
 - iii) Size for age.
- 9) Any pig, which, in the opinion of the Judges panel, does not so conform, will not be eligible to be sold through the sale ring. Reasons for rejection by the Judges Panel will be given if requested. The decision of the Judges Panel is final.
- 10) In pig sows and gilts must not be within 2 weeks of farrowing at the time of the sale
- 11) All pigs should be in good health and free from internal and external parasites and may be subject to veterinary inspection and may be quarantined or rejected.
- 12) Vendors must inform the auctioneers if any pig has received veterinary treatment requiring a withdrawal period.
- 13) Limitation of Entries. Each vendor may enter only ONE BOAR of a breed in any class.
- 14) The BPA reserves the right to impose quotas for breeds in order to ensure that all breeds are represented in the sale
- 15) Pig boards must be used by all vendors when showing
- 16) Vendors with Litters at Foot will be responsible for keeping piglets within the allocated pen
- 17) A Food Chain Information sheet should accompany all pens of fattening pigs
- 18) Movement must be carried out in accordance with all existing regulations including those described in the following paragraphs:

No pigs may be brought from their home premises, except those in approved isolation premises, to the Show and Sale within 20 days of any pigs moving onto those premises. All pigs must bear a DEFRA approved ear tag which clearly identifies the holding from which the pig is sent. This includes piglets in litters at foot. A signed Movement Licence must accompany all pigs to the Show and Sale. The Licence must be completed fully, including details of the identity mark. Blank declaration forms can be obtained from your local Trading Standards Department. All Licences will be checked on arrival at the Show and Sale. A copy of the licence must be forwarded to the local Trading Standards Department within 3 days after movement.

All pigs that are sold or otherwise disposed of or are not returning to premises of origin must be re-licensed with a Movement Licence. The Licensing Officer will be in attendance to issue Licences to purchasers. It is the responsibility of the vendor to obtain the appropriate Licences by application to his/her Local Authority. The stewards will collect all Movement Licences on arrival of the pigs at the sale premises
