## WELSH BREED

### HOOKNORTON CUP COMPETITION

#### RULES

As introduced April 1985 and amended November 1988  
and February 1991.

1. The competition to be based only on awards won at Summer Agricultural Shows.
  2. Each Show to be in receipt of Welsh Breed Committee (BPA) prize support.
  3. Classes to be judged by an official BPA judge, not necessarily from the Welsh breed panel.
  4. Points are earned by awards won either in classes restricted to Welsh pigs or in 'Other Breed' classes for which they qualify.
  5. Only 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize awards are to be considered. Lesser awards, all groups and championships are excluded.
  6. The points scale is: **1st = 5; 2nd = 3; 3rd = 1.**
- NB: A 2nd/3rd prize pig in 'Other Breeds' classes earns 3 (or 1 ) points. Even though it may be the best Welsh it does not qualify for 1st prize points.
7. The following Shows may meet the requirements on Rules 2 and 3.
